### **Height Divisions**

#### ***NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process***

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to  
designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured.  
Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog  
on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's  
jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

<u>Regular class</u>	<u>Preferred class</u>
8 inches.... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.....	4"
12 inches.....For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.....	8"
16 inches.....For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.....	12"

24 inches.... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.....	20"
26" inches at owners discretion

### **Move Up Regulations**

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition.  
However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM Monday Mar 8th, 2010.  
Day to Day Move-ups will be accommodated at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

### **Refunds**

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil  
disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond  
the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is  
absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial  
Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$10  
processing fee per day.

### **Liability**

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or  
children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly  
engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave  
the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, DOTCORN  
and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained  
by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for  
injury to children

### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American  
Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number.

Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate.  
Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive  
dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may  
affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

**Mixed breed classes** may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid. **Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?\_
