DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From Thruway (I-90) exit at Batavia (exit 48). Take Route 98 North to Route 31 (approx. 17 miles). Turn right on Route 31. Show site is 1/2 mile on left
From Canada- cross the border at Queenston - Lewiston and take Rt. 31 East to show site

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All dogs will be measured if a height card is not shown in advance or day of trial, except 24/26". If an AKC rep or VMO is present than all dogs must be measured or show proof .

8 inches.... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.....	4"
12 inches.....For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.....	8"
16 inches.....For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.....	12"
20 inches.....For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.	16"
24 inches.... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.....	20"
26 inches	At owners discretion

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM on Mon July 20th,2010. Move-ups will be accepted day to day at the trial . No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$15 processing fee per day .

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC, ILP/PAL, or Canine Partners number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Mixed breeds are eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate

Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, DQ Agility of WNY and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only.
