(Edinboro, Pa is just south of Erie . Lakeside Commons is an old mall located right on Lake Edinboro)

**From South** – Take I79 north to Exit #166 (**Edinboro Rt 6N**) turn right (east )and go 2.17 miles to Lakeside Commons (on left ).Entrance is just after the cement bridge, if you get to Taco Bell you have missed entrance . Training center is all the way around back of the building right on the lake, Suite 600. Countryside Agility Signs in window ...unloading for crating will be marked. Please do not enter with dogs at front of mall!

**From East and West** - Take I90 East or West to Rt 79 South . Get off at Exit 166 ( Edinboro Rt 6N) and turn left (east) and go 2.17 miles to Lakeside Commons on left .

**Ring will be indoors**

**Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All dogs except 24" must be measured before being shown if a height card has not been presented . If a rep or VMO is present than all dogs must show a card or be measured .

8 inches.... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.....	4"
12 inches.....For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.....	8"

**Move Up Regulations**

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM on Mon 1/18/10 . Move-ups will be accommodated day to day at the trial . No verbal changes will be accepted.

**Refunds**

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$10 processing fee and \$5 per run per day .

**Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate

**Liability**

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, APOTC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

**Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
