NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. All dogs will be measured if a height card is not shown in advance or day of trial except for 24" or 26", unless a VMO or Rep. is present.

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM on the Monday before the trial Move-ups will be accommodated Saturday to Sunday up to ½ hour after last run at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$5 processing fee PER CLASS.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, CCOC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children



Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes and stuffed toys will be awarded to the first through fourth place dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. All prizes require a qualifying score.

New Title Ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the show
A special MACH ribbon and MACH bar will be awarded to any dog earning a MACH at this trial

If you get to Taco Bell you have missed entrance. Training center is all the way around back of the building right on the lake, Suite 600. Countryside Agility Signs in window ...unloading for crating will be marked. Please do not enter with dogs at front of mall!

From East and West - Take I90 East or West to Rt 79 South . Get off at Exit 166 (Edinboro Rt 6N) and turn left (east) and go 2.7 miles to Lakeside Commons on left .

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?_
