## Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dogs in each class and division. Flat ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying scores. New Title Ribbons will be awarded to any dog earning a title at the show.

### **New This Year: recognition of Double & Triple Qs**

**Dog neck sashes will be awarded to any dog earning an Exc. B double Q (STD + JWW).**

**Dog neck sashes will be awarded to any dog earning a Triple Q on Friday or Saturday. A triple Q is a Q in JWW, STD and FAST. Dog is not required to compete at the same level in all 3 classes.**

A special PAX ribbon and PAX bar will be awarded to any dog earning a PAX title at this trial.

A special MACH ribbon and MACH bar will be awarded to any dog earning a MACH at this trial along with their name engraved on a plaque on the new perpetual Agility Trophy donated by Jo Bill in honor of MACH Shakan Caithness Dakota Wanagi UD RN.

### Camping

### Directions to Show site

**From the EAST:** Take I-90 NYS Thruway to Exit 43, turn left (north) on Route 21, at the light turn left onto Route 31, take route 31 to Canandaigua Rd.(Dunkin Donuts and CVS on this corner). Turn Right on Canandaigua Rd, Bullis Park is ½ mile on your left.

**From the WEST:** Take I-90, NYS Thruway to Exit 44. This exits right onto Route 332 south. At first light turn left onto Collette Rd. At 2<sup>nd</sup> intersection turn left onto County Road #8. Follow this road about 5 miles north, it becomes Canandaigua Rd at Wayne Co. line. Continue across Route 31(Burger King, P&C grocery on the left) and Bullis Park is ½ mile on the left.

## Height Divisions

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All dogs that do not have a permanent height card must tell us if they need to be measured. **Dee Crofton, VMO (volunteer measuring official) will be present all 3 days to measure your dog before you run.**

### NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

### Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM Mon. May 17, 2010. Day to Day move-ups will be accommodated at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

### Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will receive a refund with proof from a vet. Refund will be less \$10 per day processing fee

### Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, DOTCORN and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for a loss damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

**Mixed breed dogs** enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. **Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.**

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? \_\_\_\_\_
