Thank you for entering the Irish Setter Club of America national agility trial. Please check your confirmation letter carefully to see if there are any errors. I want to make sure the information is correct as entered in our database for these trials. If there are any problems or corrections, contact Denise Thomas at CSTrialEntries@aol.com. It is much easier to make corrections prior to the trial! Move-ups MUST be in my hands in writing **by Tuesday, May 29 at 6 pm (per AKC rules)**.

Making sure your dog is measured is now the responsibility of the exhibitor. We do not need to see your height card but it is your responsibility to get a measurement done if needed before you show and you should always have your card available if requested. The judge is a VMO at this trial and will measure dogs throughout the trial as available. **If you checked that your dog needs to be measured on your entry form, then you will have to be measured before running.** Armbands are no longer required and will not be provided at this trial.

The trial site is outdoors on the hotel lawn and will start judging at 7:30 am, Please bring your own shelter and chairs. The hotel will have food available. Tents may be set up after 4 PM on Monday

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Sawmill Creek Resort and Convention Center

From the Cleveland Hopkins Airport: Follow signs for Route 480 West to Ohio Turnpike (80) West to Exit 135 (Baumhart road/Vermilion), proceed North on Baumhart Road to Route 2 West. Go West on Route 2 to Rye Beach Road exit. Turn right onto Rye Beach Road. At the traffic light, turn left onto Cleveland Road (SR 6). The Lodge is located 500 yards around the bend on the right side of the road.

From Cleveland (East) on Ohio Turnpike (80/90): West to Exit 135, follow the above directions.

From Cleveland (I-90): Go West on Route 90 past Elyria To Route 2 West. Stay to your right on Route 90, Route 90 becomes Route 2 in Elyria. Stay on Route 2 to Rye Beach Road Exit. Follow direction above.

From Columbus: Take Route 23 North to Route 98 North to Route 4 North to Route 2 East. Go East on Route 2 to the Rye Beach Road Exit. Turn left onto Rye Beach Road. Follow directions above. OR Take I-71 to Route 13 North, which will join Route 250. Stay on Route 250 North until Route 2. Follow Rte 2 East to Rye Beach Road exit. Turn left off exit. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Cleveland Road (Rte 6). The Lodge is located 500 yards around the bend on the right side of the road.

From Dayton/Cincinnati: Take I-71 To Columbus. Follow above directions **OR** I-75 North to Route 12 North to Route 6 East, To Route 2 East. Follow Route 2 East to Rye Beach Road Exit. Turn left onto Rye Beach Road. Go to traffic light, turn left onto Cleveland Road (SR 6). The Lodge is located 500 yards around the bend on the right side of the road.

From Toledo/Detroit: I-75 South to Route 280 South. Follow Route 280 to I-80- 90 (Ohio Turnpike). Take Turnpike East to Exit 118 (Route 250 North). Go North on 250 approximately 7 miles to Route 2. Take Route 2 East to the Rye Beach Road Exit. Turn left onto Rye Beach Road. Go to traffic light, turn left onto Cleveland Road (SR6). The Lodge is located 500 yards around the bend on the right side of the road.

Monday, June 4 at 5pm at the show grounds, there will be a Pay 'N Play Open to all current ISCA members. Membership of the handler (not the owner) will be verified.

Toys are allowed but dog treats are not.

Signups and walkthroughs are from 4-5pm.

There will be two courses available, JWW and STD.

Each run is \$10 for 2 minutes.

Members may pay in cash or by check payable to "ISCA".

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

In all areas of competition, a rosette will be awarded to any dog completing a title. A rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning a Double Q (STD & JWW), Triple Q or Quad Q, for all levels. ISCA Bronze Medallions for first through fourth places for all levels.

HIGH IN TRIAL will receive a Bronze Trophy with Irish Setter Motif offered by the Irish Setter Club of America, Inc. Two High in Trials (HIT) will be awarded on the basis of number of Q's - one for Regular jump heights and one for Preferred classes.

High in Trial will be calculated as follows:

1. All Irish Setters competing in all levels.
2. Only Standard and JWW classes to count.
3. The total number of Q's earned.
4. The dog with the highest total score for Q's earned.

Tie Breakers:

1. Average yards per second for all Q's.
2. Dog with the highest level Q's.
